General Information:

Ticket Sales Campaign: November 1 – November 22, 2024

No tickets will be sold after midnight November 22, 2024 and the draw will proceed based on the tickets sold as of that date.

The Wine Survivor Lottery is open only to participants who are 19 years of age or older. The ticket purchaser must be physically present in the Province of Ontario at the time of purchase.

The price of the ticket to participate in the draw is \$40 for a single ticket or \$100 for a bundle of three tickets.

Total number of tickets to be printed: 400

Draws:

An **Early Bird draw** will be held at 7:30 pm on Sunday, November 10, 2024. Only tickets purchased prior to 6 pm November 10, 2024 are eligible for the Early Bird draw. The winner of the Early Bird draw remains eligible for the Wine Survivor Elimination draws.

Wine Survivor Elimination draws start: 7:30 pm, November 25, 2024 Final draw: 7:30 pm, December 6, 2024 Number of draws: 10 (weekdays only)

Early Bird and Elimination draws will take place at 5418 Eighth Line or 9335 27 Sideroad, Erin, ON. The final draws on December 8 will take place at 5711 Second Line, Erin, ON. All draws will be live streamed on Zoom and will be video recorded for transparency and integrity. The Zoom link will be provided to all ticket holders.

Winners' names will be published on the Erin Rotary website.

Prize Schedule:

Total Value of Prizes: \$4,065.00 (based on 200 bottles of wine valued at \$20 per bottle plus \$65.)

Early Bird Prize:

One Bottle of Premium wine from Dobbin Estate Winery valued at \$75.

Consolation Prizes:

Awarded to the holder of the first ticket drawn each night – 1 bottle of wine each.

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Ticketing:

All ticket sales will be conducted on-line. Interested participants will register using the on-line registration form. Once registered, participants will be sent an email with instructions to e-transfer their entry fee to winesurvivorerin@gmail.com

Once the e-transfer has been accepted the participant will be advised of their ticket number by email. The paper portion of their ticket will be sent by Canada Post mail to the address they have provided. The draw portion for that ticket number will be placed in the drum. Both portions of the ticket will include the unique ticket number and all of the information specified in the AGCO Raffle Licence Terms and Conditions.

Erin Rotary will create and maintain a spreadsheet to track paid participants. The e-transfer payment will be linked to the corresponding ticket number.

Draw Procedure:

A single Early Bird draw will be held on November 10. The winner of the Early Bird draw remains eligible for the Wine Survivor Elimination draw. The winning Early Bird ticket will be returned to the drum.

The Wine Survivor draw is an elimination draw. For each ticket drawn, the ticket holder is "voted off the island".

The committee will send out the launch email (bcc all ticket holders) on November 25 to remind everyone that the draws begin that evening. The launch email will inform the ticket holders of the total number of tickets sold and indicate the number of tickets to be drawn each night.

Beginning on November 25 and over the course of ten draws, tickets will be drawn from the drum until the final draw on December 6. During the final draw tickets will be withdrawn until only ten Survivor tickets remain. The remaining ten are Survivor prize winners and will be awarded prizes in accordance with the Prize Schedule. The last remaining ticket will be the First Prize winner.

Each weekday evening at 7:30 pm, we will draw up to 40 tickets from the raffle drum. This number may be adjusted depending on the total number of tickets sold such that approximately 10% of the tickets are drawn each night.

A Consolation Prize of one bottle of wine awarded to the holder of the first ticket drawn each night.
